



The World's Highest Standards In Railroad Wheel Sets

FROM I-80 TRAVELING EAST

If you are driving a tractor-trailer, this route encompasses a long, twisting, steep downhill stretch of roadway. You may want to continue east on I-80 to Exit 158 (Milesburg), and then follow the directions From I-80 Travelling West.

1. You will take Exit 123 (Woodland) and go south on Route 970 for 1 mile to Route 322.
2. Take 322 east for 11 miles to Philipsburg.
3. In Philipsburg, you will have to meander through town a little bit, but just follow the signs for Route 350 east toward Tyrone.
4. It is 14 miles, almost all downhill, from Philipsburg to Bald Eagle, which is not easily identified as Bald Eagle except for a very small sign that you will probably not see. However, it will be at the bottom of the mountain after the road has straightened and levelled. There will be a traffic light at an intersection and a Snappy's convenience store on the left.
5. In Bald Eagle, you will go straight through the traffic light (make sure it's green) onto the entrance ramp for I-99 South.
6. Take 99 South for approximately 8 miles to Exit 45 (Tipton-Grazierville).
7. Head down the ramp, over the annoying rumble strips, to the stop sign and turn right.
8. Head down the hill to the flashing red light and turn left.
9. Go about two miles to a traffic light at River Road where you will turn right. You cannot turn left at this light. (This is just after you pass a small amusement park (Delgrosso's Amusement Park) with its water slides, overhead walkway, and little roller coaster.)
10. Follow River Road for 3/10 of a mile to the Ardie J. Dillen Industrial Park.
11. Turn right into the park, and go straight ahead to ORX.
